



This Privacy Policy applies to the mbac-us.com website

We recognize the importance of maintaining your privacy. We value your privacy and appreciate your trust in us. This Policy describes how we treat user information we collect on the website. This Privacy Policy applies to current and former visitors to our website. By visiting and/or using our website, you agree to this Privacy Policy and consent to processing purposes specified herein.

Information you submit. We might collect your name, email, phone number, ip address and contents of your message when you submit a message to us through the website. Other information. If you use our website, we may passively collect information about your ip address and the browser you're using. We might also collect the type of mobile device you are using, or the version of the operating system your computer or device is running. We use tracking tools like



Google Analytics, Google Webmaster, browser cookies and web beacons for collecting information about your usage of our website.
